

Your community is at risk of Flash Flooding

Stay Safe. Do you know what to do?



Extreme flash flooding is dangerous and can happen very quickly. The effects can be devastating.

Be aware and know the signs:

- Heavy rain or severe weather reports
- Rising water levels with churning dark water
- A build up of debris in rivers or streams

Check to see if your insurance covers flooding

Know how to turn off gas, electricity and water supplies

Plan where to go if you get caught in a flash flood

What to do if there is a flash flood

Call 999 if there's a risk to life, or if you're trapped

Do not walk or drive through flood water

If you are in a building with at least two storeys and you believe it is safer to stay where you are, move to a higher floor

Follow advice from the emergency services
